LOA Vital Transportation Expands to North Botetourt County

LOA's [Vital Transportation](#) services has recently expanded its reach to help even more seniors with transportation needs!

Now, eligible seniors in Blue Ridge, Buchanan, Cloverdale, Daleville, Eagle Rock, Fincastle, Glen Wilson, Iron Gate, Laymantown, and Troutville

can get assistance going to their doctor, pharmacy, grocery store, or any other vital services.

Vital Transportation is available to individuals 60 or older with lower income, who need a ride to their critical appointments. We help those who have no other source for transportation or means to pay for transportation. (Riders must be able to get in and out of the vehicle on their own.)

Summer heat can quickly become a safety issue for at-risk seniors. LOA offers small window unit air conditioners to homeowners with no working air conditioner in the home. Box fans are also available for those who do not own their home. There are some additional eligibility requirements for this program.

Farm Market Fresh

Senior & WIC Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (S/FMNP)

Low- to moderate-income older adults may be eligible for fresh and nutritious locally grown fruit, vegetables, and cut herbs through the 2025 Farm Market Fresh Program!

Seniors aged 60 and older with income of less than \$2413/month are eligible to apply. Qualified seniors will receive \$50 worth of benefits (on a digital app or physical card) to buy fresh produce from participating farmers through November. The Local Office on Aging held its **Virtual Public Hearing** on the Fiscal Year 2026 Area Plan for Aging Services for the 5th Planning District of Virginia (counties of Roanoke, Botetourt, Craig, and Alleghany, and the cities of Roanoke, Salem, and Covington) on June 25.

Open to the public, the hearing outlined the Area Plan for the 2025-2026 fiscal year, covering the programs and services provided to older adults who reside in the 5th Planning District. The LOA Advisory Council will use the information gained to finalize the plan for LOA Board approval in July.
