

It's a Great Time to Apply for Farm Market Fresh

It's harvest season in our area, a great time to get fresh fruit and vegetables! The Farm Market Fresh program helps qualifying seniors age 60 and older gain access to fresh produce at local farmers markets. Eligible seniors receive \$50 on a digital app or card to buy fresh produce at local farmers. Due to the popularity of the program, LOA has received additional funding for seniors in our area! Seniors who qualify can receive the benefit through September 30, and they have until November 30 to use the funds. There are participating farmers at the Grandin Village and West End Farmers Markets in Roanoke, and at the Salem Farmers Market. Seniors 60 and over can apply using the link below.
